



## **House Rules**

We appreciate our residents are going through a particularly stressful time in their lives. Accordingly, the Homes has House Rules to ensure the well-being, safety, and comfort of everyone.

We expect that while staying with us that all residents are respectful of each other and follow the guidelines below:

- Keep noise to a reasonable level so as not to disturb others, particularly when outside your room or on the balcony.
- Show consideration and respect for the dignity and privacy of other residents.
- Notify the office if there are additional people staying overnight in the room with you.
- Comply with requests from staff and resident carers.
- Limit your consumption of alcohol to a safe level that does not endanger yourself or others.
- Understanding, and complying that prohibited drug use is not acceptable.
- Respect the property of others.
- Do not damage or misuse the property of the Homes.
- Report to the office any damage or breakages so we can appropriately repair or replace the item.
- Understanding and complying that Smoking is prohibited in the buildings, individual rooms, and balconies. A smokers' pavilion is provided near the back-car park in between buildings 10 and 12.
- Staff reserve the right to arrange and conduct a room inspection with the residents.

Should a staff member or resident carer believe a visitor's conduct is inappropriate or likely to affect the safety and security of others, staff may request residents and their visitors to leave the premises.

Repeat offenders will not be invited to return.
